How to install eSim on Windows OS?

1 The procedure to install eSim in Windows 10

1.1 Getting ready for eSim installation

- 1. If you have an older version of eSim, released on 24 March 2020 or before, please read the Uninstalling eSim section before you proceed ahead.
- 2. To follow the installation procedure, you need to be connected to the Internet.
- 3. Disable any anti-virus software running on your system (e.g. Norton, Kaspersky, AVG, Avast etc.)

1.2 Installing eSim on your machine

- 1. Download the latest eSim release for Windows OS from the link: https://esim.fossee.in/downloads.
- 2. Locate the installer file in the folder where your downloaded files are kept.
- 3. Double click on the file.
- 4. If a pop-up window appears asking "Do you want to allow the following program from an unknown publisher to make changes to this computer?", click YES.
- 5. Then in the "License Agreement" window, select the I Agree option.
- 6. Click **Next** when the program asks for you to "Choose Install Location". We have taken care to auto-select the destination folder path.
- 7. In the next window that appears, select **Install**.
- 8. A progress bar will appear; once it reaches 100%, "Installation Complete" message will be shown at the top of the eSim setup window. Click on Close. eSim shortcut icon will be on your Desktop.

2 Uninstalling eSim

2.1 March 2020 onward:

To uninstall eSim and all of its components, run the file "uninst-eSim.exe" located in the "eSim" folder.

2.2 Older version of eSim - July 2019 or older than that

If you have an older version of eSim on your computer, released on 4th July 2019 or before, please follow the instructions below:

- Go to C:/FOSSEE/ and delete the entire eSim folder present under C:/FOSSEE/
 - OR the appropriate location at which eSim is present
- 2. Go to C:/Program Files (x86)/KiCad/ and run the uninstaller.exe application.
