
Title: River Network of Mandakini Basin

he Mandakini River is a tributary of the Alaknanda River in the Indian state of Uttarakhand.

The river runs for approximately 81 kilometres (50 mi) between the Rudraprayag and Sonprayag areas and emerges from the Chorabari Glacier.

The river merges with river Songanga at Sonprayag flows Hindu the and past temple Madhyamaheshwar at Ukhimath.

At the end of its course it drains into the Alaknada, which flows into the Ganges.

The Mandakini is considered a sacred river within Uttarakhand as it runs past the Kedarnath and Madhyamaheshwar temples.
