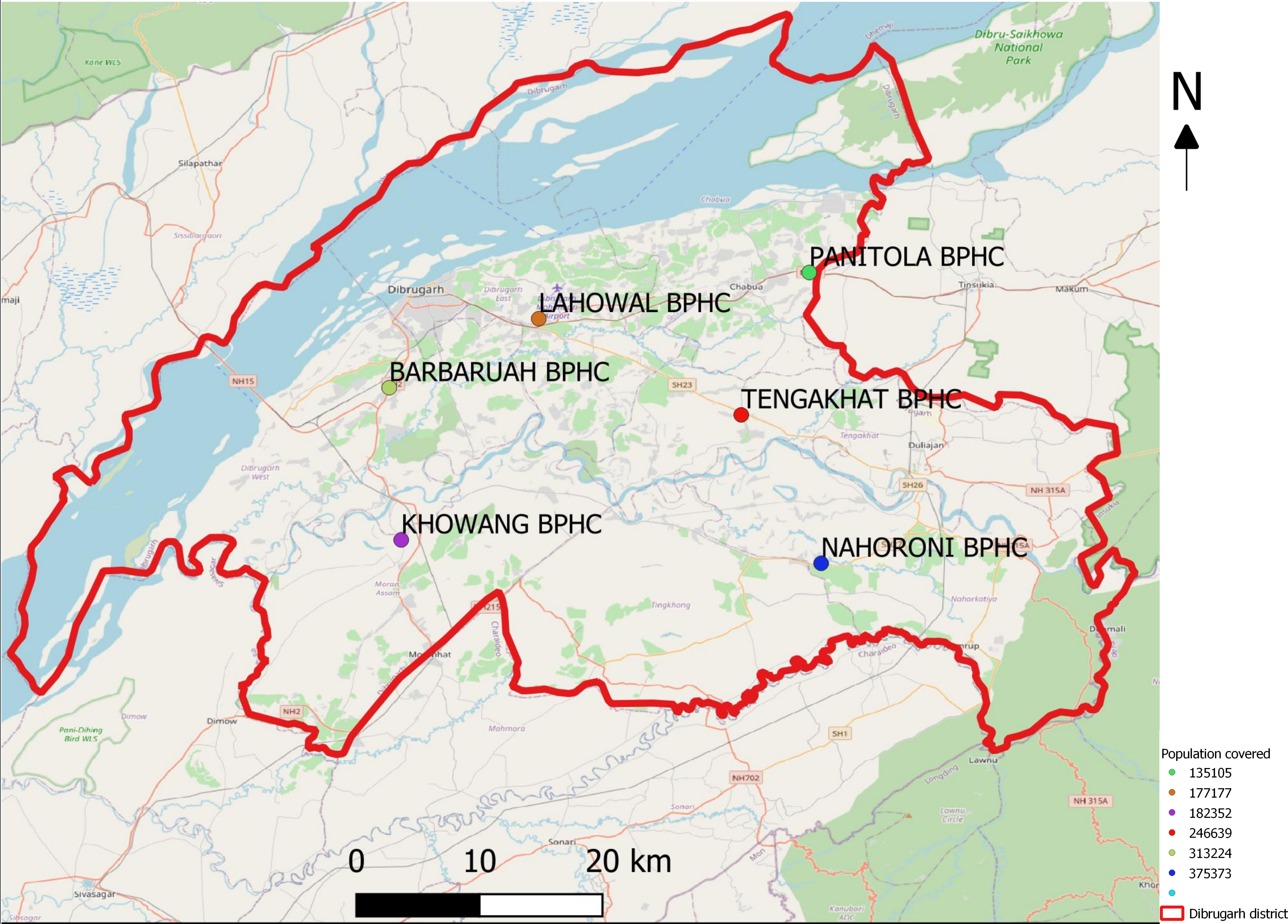


Title: Block Primary Health Centres of Dibrugarh District and Population covered by each Block

Map description



Study area: Dibrugarh district extends from 27o5' 38" N to 27o42' 30" N latitude and 94o33' 46" E to 95o29'8" E longitude. The area stretches from the North Bank of the mighty Brahmaputra, which flow a length of 95 kms through the northern margin of the district, to the Patkai foothills on the South.

Primary Health Infrastructure: The district is divided into 6 health blocks. These health blocks operates around 26 primary health centres which covers 11 Mini PHCs (MPHC), 8 State Dispensary (SD), 2 Urban Health Centres (UHC) and 216 Sub-centres (SC).
(NB: SCs are mapped seperately)
