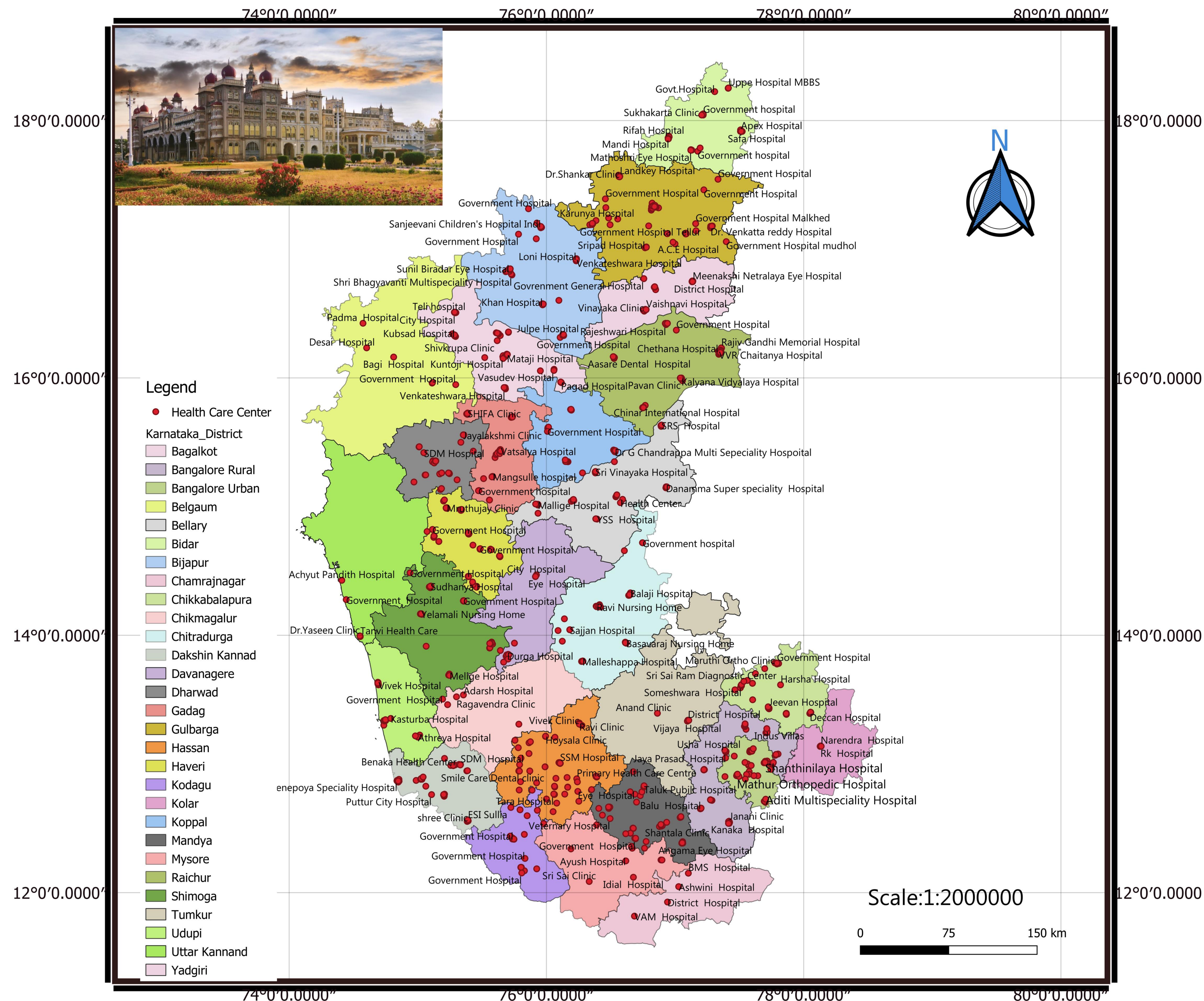


Title: Health care center map in Karnataka State Region
