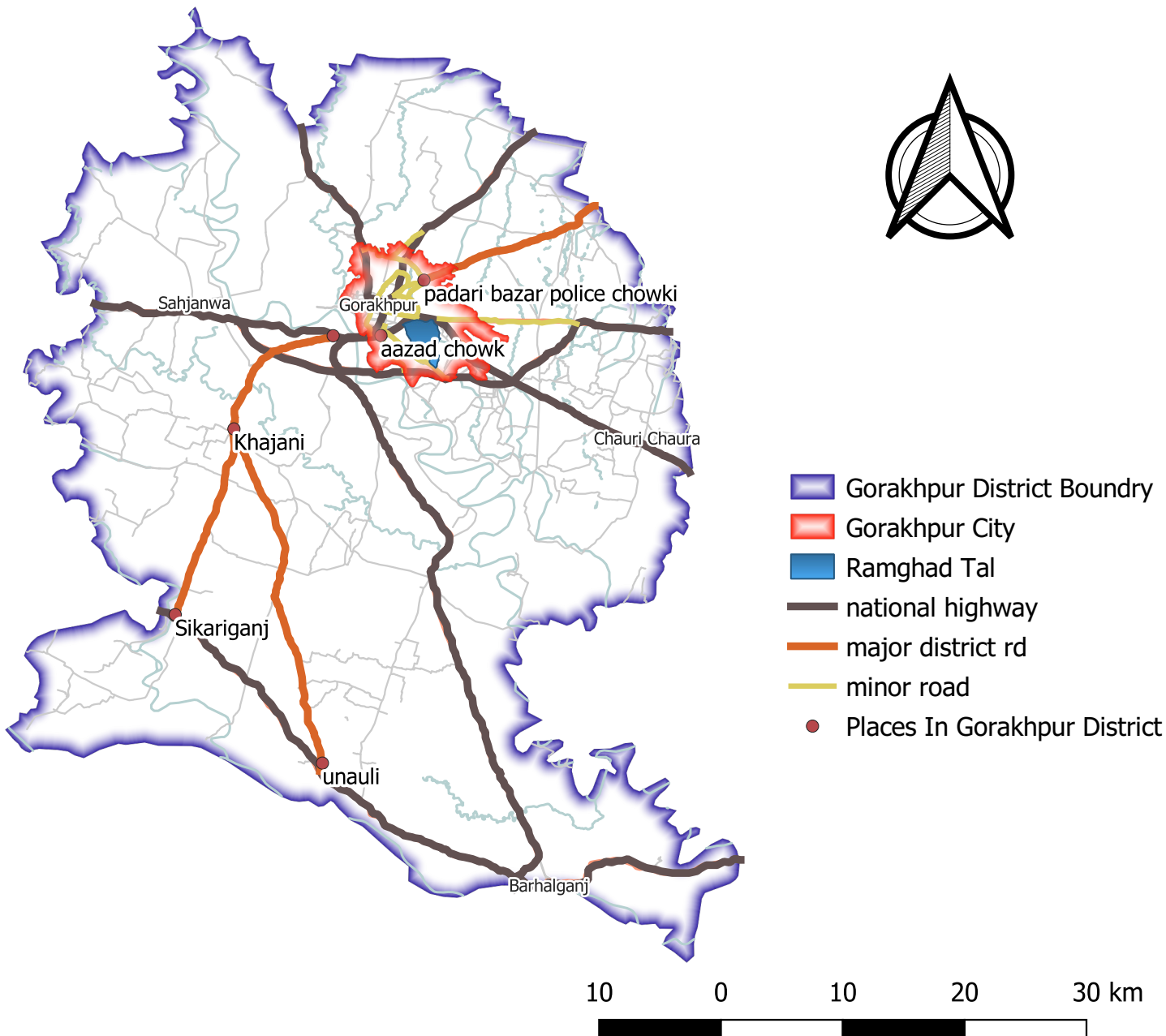


Road network map of Gorakhpur district

Map description and analysis



INTRODUCTION

Gorakhpur is a district of Uttar Pradesh, India. It is one of the major districts of Uttar Pradesh having area 3,448 Km² and population 4.44 lakhs.

ROAD NETWORKS

• NATIONAL HIGHWAYS

Two national highways NH27 and NH24 pass through Gorakhpur district. NH24 covers total 98.280 Km of length over Gorakhpur region. It has two parts:- Gorakhpur Farendanautanwa Sonauli Marg (44.000Km) Varanashi Gazipur Gorakhpur Marg (54.280Km)

NH27 covers 61.000 Km of length over Gorakhpur district region. It has two spur roads (NH227A and NH727A) alongwith one secondary route (NH 727BB), which is also known as Lucknow Makama Road.

• MAJOR DISTRICT ROAD

There are three major district roads in Gorakhpur district-

1. MD 573E (Gorakhpur Pipraich Kaptangang Naurgiya Marg) having length of 12.600Km
2. MD 163E (Khajani Malharpar Dasavpur Marg) having length of 34.800 Km
3. MD 49E (Gorakhpur Khajani Sikariganj Marg) having length of 31.440 Km

• MINOR ROADS

Taramandal Road, Rustampur Road, Kasaya Road etc. are minor roads in Gorakhpur City (administrative head of Gorakhpur district).



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
